Local Karen guide will accompany on a walk around 2 hours to the lovely hidden waterfall "Pa Dok Siaw" and the breathtaking scenery along the way, followed by a visit to the first original coffee local café. You might also enjoy selecting handcrafted fabrics from local community.
- 11:00

Meeting Nu at the drop point “Baan Mae Klang Luang” and go downhill to the valley farm by his truck, continue with the organic farm tour which you will enjoy learning the way of Eco’s life, the wisdom & technics of planting and harvesting then picking the fresh seasonal organic fruits and flowers by hands!
- 12:30

Picnic lunch by Nu’s family who will cook the local dishes and fresh vegetable from their farm at the tree house which was built for his lovely daughters, Nadia and Jija.

- 13:30

Before goodbye to Nu, he will bring us to plant the local tree “Bauhinia variegata” which is our afforestation project for carbon credit benefits. And it sources of the waterfall’s name Pa Dok Siaw.
- 14:00

Leaving Nu’s farm and stop at the highest peak of Thailand with the Stupa of King Inthawitchayanon, the last King of Lanna Kingdom before we became Siam and Thailand later on. Continue to the Twin Pagodas for King Bhumibhol and QueenSirikit of Thailand as the 60th years birthday anniversary which built by Thai Lada Air Force and locals. Inside the pagodas, see the beautiful art which telling about the Lords Buddha.

PONG KRAI ORGANIC COFFEE PLANTATION TRAIL



Follow the story of our Pong Krai Organic Forest Coffee, served at Raya Heritage, and learn about its production by visiting the coffee's plantation itself as part of the Baan Pong Krai Community Tourism program. Get to know the local villagers and participate in an environmental conservation activity provided by the village. Join our wild orchid breeding activities and enjoy planting them in the forest along the natural path to propagate the Fah Mui orchid, Thailand's very rare blue-purple colored wild orchids, as a legacy for their descendants to appreciate.

"Pong Krai Coffee" Arabica coffee bean, is a Catimor breeding line from Columbia. It has been well-grown at an altitude of 1,000 to 1,100 meters above sea level under the shade of forest trees in Baan Pong Krai, Maerim, Chiang Mai since 2014 until now. The beans were first harvested by hand in 2016 using the Wet Process to extract cherry beans from the pulps, dry and prepare for artisan roasting. It usually takes 6 months to ferment the shell coffee before the beans are roasted. The annual yield of coffee cherries ranges from 12,000 to 16,000 kilograms per year.

TRAVELLING PROGRAM

- 8:00 Depart from hotel to Baan Pong Krai.
- 8:45 Stop at Baan Pong Krai Orchid Conservation Center and join the orchid breeding activities.
- 9:30 Visit Pong Krai Temple, a temple built by the faithful villagers and the Sichonlakorn Pagoda.

Plant the orchid into the forest as well as the Indian Willow tree (*Salix tetrasperma* Roxb.) as part of our afforestation initiative aimed at generating carbon credits.
- 10:00 Trail into the natural forest coffee plantation for about 1 kilometer in distance. Get to discover the full process of coffee bean production, including the drying, fermenting and roasting.
- 11:45 Enjoy making your freshly brewed coffee with the hands-on instruction by the local barista.
- 12:00 Lunch consisting of traditional Thai food recipes by Chef Aunty Tim at Tune In Garden (Bib Gourmand - Michelin Guide Thailand 2022), the house of legendary Thai artist and writer Khun Rong Wongsawan, before returning to the hotel.
- 15:00 Arrive Raya Heritage safe & sound.

LOCAL TEMPLE & MARKET TOUR BY RICKSHAW

Explore the historic heart of Chiang Mai city and visit many of its most interesting sites by 'samlor' (a typical, old style cart which seats two and is pulled by a bicycle in the front). Enjoy a pleasant morning ride to Wat Pan Waen and visit a lively local market at Chiang Mai gate to observe the daily life of Chiang Mai people before continuing on the ride past historical monuments in Chiang Mai such as Wat Jed Lin before returning to the hotel.

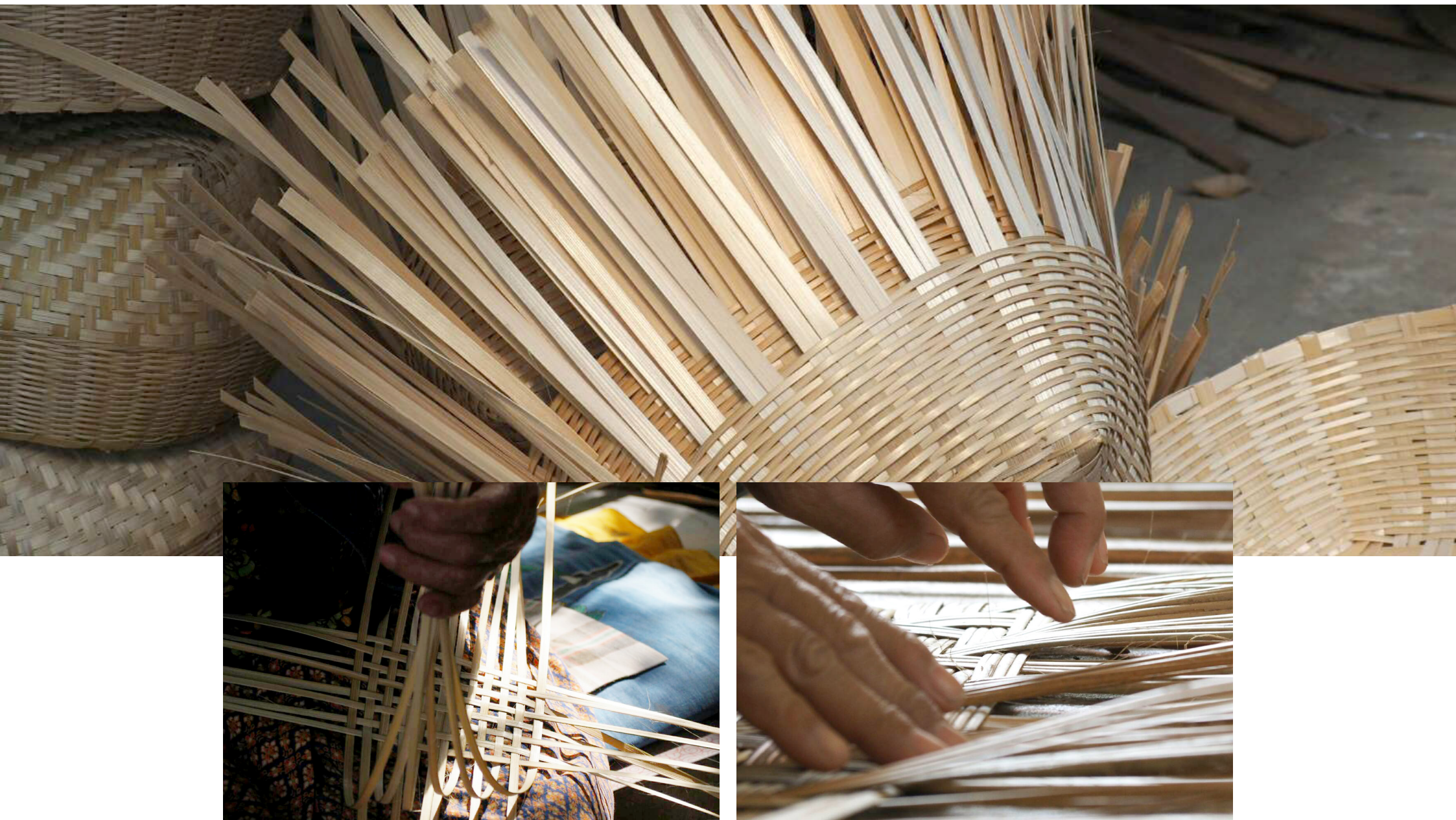

THE BASIC BASKETRYWORKSHOP WITH ARTISANS

Ban Pa Bong (Pa Bong Village) is famous for creating bamboo woven works that are inherited from ancestors. The basketry that still exists until the present day is the basket and fish traps. Which the former is used for everyday life, but is currently used for decoration. The unique pattern of the village is "Lai Mee Dee" from the basket and "Kratue pattern" from "Khong Luang" (a large fish trap) and the development of new patterns is "Flowing Water" These patterns are used in basketry to be a unique product such as baskets, trays, vases, lamps and room dividers. In addition, the wickerwork of Ban Pa Bong also developed the use of rattan as a material. "Mua pattern" which can be used as a lamp, trays and boxes.

Raya Heritage value the Lanna folk wisdom by bringing wicker furniture, natural fabrics, earthenware and other handcrafts to decorate hotel and guest room in order to preserve Lanna folk wisdom remaining sustainable.
